1	3	<p>Slip/trip/fall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise group to wear appropriate footwear • Advise group that bedrock may be slippery
2	2	<p>Vegetation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warn group to watch out for overhanging vegetation • Advise group to wear long sleeves/trousers
3	5	<p>Drowning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check the depth of the river before allowing the students in • Advise students that the river may vary in depth, particularly on a meander • Carry a throw line • Advise groups to stay together
4	5	<p>Weil's disease</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform students of the risk of leptospirosis, symptoms and treatment. • Advise students to cover any open wounds - rubber gloves could be worn.
5	6	<p>Getting wet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise students to bring spare clothes • Group to be supervised
6	5	<p>Traffic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise students to look for traffic before exiting the minibus • Advise students not to stand in the road whilst waiting next to the minibuses • Advise students to walk along the edge of the road where necessary

7	6	<p>Weather</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check weather forecast prior to session• Advise group on appropriate clothing• Advise groups to wear hat/sun cream if necessary• Advise groups to carry spare water/clothes if necessary• Monitor group throughout the day
8	2	<p>General public</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Advise group to be polite to any members of the general public they may come across
