

Rocky Shore Working Information Card

Updated: March 2010

This working information card is to be read in conjunction with the Generic 'Out of Classroom' Risk Assessment, the 'Walking' Generic Activity Risk Assessment and the 'Marine' and 'Rural' Generic Environmental Risk Assessments.

Main Hazards

1. **Slip/trip/fall:** warn students to walk and step on the rocks rather than run and jump!
2. **Steep slopes:** remind students to bring inhaler if needed
3. **Drowning:** carry a throw line, and check tide times.
4. **Rock fall:** wear helmets if working underneath cliffs.
5. **Ticks:** Warn students about the presence of ticks

Transport

Vehicle access points
There is no good vehicle access onto the shore. The closest you can get is the National Trust car-park or the houses to the South of East Prawle overlooking Gorah Rocks

East Prawle village green (can be accessed by a coach)
National trust car-park (this can be accessed by minibuses, but it is quite tight).

In an emergency

Nearest dwelling: East Prawle (TQ7 2BY) or the Coast Watch station at Prawle Point

Escape routes:
There is a footpath back to the road to East Prawle between Langerstone and the National Trust car-park. It is quite steep. There is a shortcut down to Gorah across the field just past the last house, but it is very steep and slippery when wet

Phones: There is no signal in any of this area. It is patchy in East Prawle. Public phone in East Prawle.
