

Shingle Ridge Working Information Card

This working information card is to be read in conjunction with the Generic 'Out of Classroom' Risk Assessment, the 'Walking' and 'Soil Analysis' Generic Activity Risk Assessments and the 'Marine' and 'Rural' Generic Environmental Risk Assessments.

Main Hazards

- 1. Drowning:** students are not to go in to the sea. Carry a throw-line.
- 2. Traffic:** Students should wear yellow vests, warn students about narrow gaps when crossing from the seaward side to the back-slope to avoid them backing up in the road. Wait for a long gap before crossing large groups
- 3. Strand-line debris:** warn students about possibility of rubbish and sharp debris.

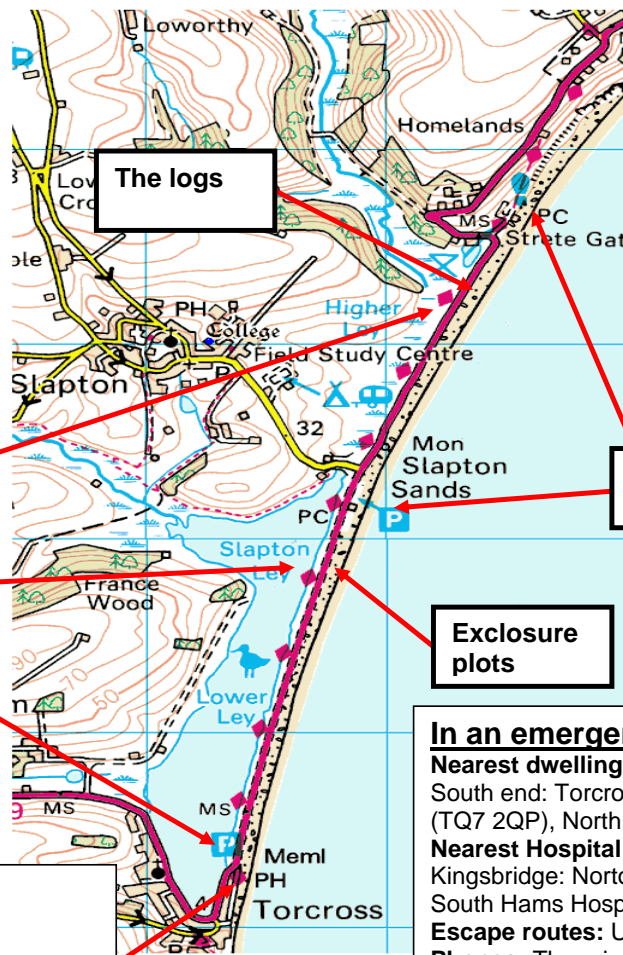
Warn students about prickly vegetation and the possibility of seeing adders on the back-slope.
