

What is FSC Margam Discovery Centre like?

A low-carbon footprint building, Margam Discovery Centre boasts both natural and made attractions, such as 600 free roaming deer and an Iron Age fort, culminating in rich opportunities for studying.

Accommodation

Each bedroom will sleep a maximum of 4 and all rooms are en-suite with toilet, sink and shower. The centre provides all bed linen, but you will need to bring your own towels. The standard price for FSC courses is for sole occupancy accommodation but shared and non-resident options are usually available at a reduced rate.

It is important to note that the Fire Alarm system is very sensitive to the use of aerosol sprays, therefore please do not use sprays in the rooms as this can trigger the fire alarm.

Staffed 24 Hours a Day

FSC centres operate a 24/7 duty system to ensure your stay runs as smoothly as possible. The details and location of the person on duty can be found on the notice board outside the senior common room.

Food & Drink

Meals are served at different times depending on the number of groups at the centre. Breakfast is usually served between 8.00–8.30am Dinner between 6.00-7.00pm in the Refectory. On your arrival you will be informed of your meal times. Provided the centre is informed in advance, any special dietary requirements can be catered for. For those having packed lunches, an information sheet will be given to you during dinner to complete for your packed lunch the following morning.

Recreational Activities

In addition to formal tea breaks in the refectory, tea and coffee is also available in the common room and in your bedrooms. If you require top ups please ask the person on duty. We have two common rooms with TV/DVD and also there are several DVD's to watch in the evening, along with a small book library. You can also use the staff area in the cafe or feel free to use our outdoor spaces. Margam doesn't have a bar on site but you are welcome to bring your own drinks.
