

What is FSC Juniper Hall like?

In a quiet wooded valley in an unspoilt area of the chalk North Downs, Juniper Hall is a superb country house dating from the 17th century, complete with a butterfly garden and surrounding woodland.

Accommodation

Juniper Hall has two accommodation blocks; the Main House and the separate Cedars building. We can accommodate up to 130 guests.

- The Centre has 11 dormitories, 12 three-bedded rooms, five twin rooms and two singles.
- All rooms have a sink and bathrooms are close by.
- Nine of our rooms are at ground floor level.
- Fifteen of these rooms are in the Cedars building which can be taken by a whole group (totalling 40 beds).

Accommodation is available on a sole occupancy or shared basis and non-resident options are usually available at a reduced rate. Each family on our family holiday courses will get a room to themselves.

Bed linen and towels are included, and each room has tea/coffee making facilities.

Staffed 24 Hours a Day

Juniper Hall centre has a 24 hour duty system so there is always somebody on hand to help if you need it.

Food & Drink

The centre serves a cooked breakfast and a healthy evening meal using fresh ingredients. If you have any special food requirements please let a member of staff know before you arrive at Juniper Hall, we are able to cater for all requirements with appropriate notice. At breakfast there will be a variety of ingredients provided so you can make your own packed lunch. Cake is also available in the afternoon.

- Breakfast: Start the day with a cooked breakfast, selection of cereals and/or toast.
- Picnic lunch: Most courses require you to prepare a packed lunch from a choice of bread, sandwich fillings, fruit and snacks provided.
- Evening meal: Enjoy three course meals each evening, always including a vegetarian option.
- Snacks: Homemade cakes, tea, coffee and cold drinks are available in pantry areas.

Recreational Activities

The centre has a comfortable sitting room with TV and a separate student common room with table football, TV plus hot and cold drink facilities. Bar facilities are available on request. Wi-Fi access is available throughout all of the centre.

Juniper Hall grounds extend to approximately one hectare and include a large lawn area with benches. There is also a public footpath leading up to Box Hill from the grounds.
