


## FSC Juniper Hall Directions



In a quiet wooded valley in an unspoilt area of the chalk North Downs, Juniper Hall is a superb country house dating from the 17th century, complete with a butterfly garden and surrounding woodland.

### By Train

**Dorking Station** (approx. 2 miles) - regular trains from London (Victoria and Waterloo) and Horsham. Taxis are readily available outside the main station.

**Dorking Deepdene** (approx. 2 miles) – trains from Reading, Guildford and Gatwick stop at Dorking Deepdene station. This station is a short walk from the mainline station.

**Box Hill and Westhumble** (1 mile) - regular trains from London (Victoria and Waterloo) and Horsham. About a 20 minute walk from Juniper Hall.

### By Bus

The **465 service** runs from opposite Dorking station and stops just outside Juniper Hall (Headley Lane stop). The route runs from Teddington and Kingston to Dorking via Leatherhead. Please note to pay fares passengers need an Oyster Card or contactless debit card on this service.

The **489 service** operating between Leatherhead and Merstham also stops as a request stop directly outside the Centre. This service accepts cash payments.

## By Car



**SAT-NAV** Please use the postcode **RH5 6BZ**.  
Please note this is different to our postal post code.

**From junction 9 of the M25:** Take the A24 towards Dorking. At the Texaco garage (Givons Grove roundabout) turn left to continue on the A24. Follow the A24 south for approximately 1 mile and then take the B2209 left into the village of Mickleham. Go through the village past the Church and the Running Horses pub and continue for about ½ mile. The entrance to Juniper Hall is on the left hand side immediately after Headley Lane. *Please note that there is **no** entrance to the centre from Headley Lane.*

**From the south:** Join the A24 and from Dorking head North towards Leatherhead. Go straight over the Denbies Vineyard roundabout (cyclist statue) and at the next roundabout (Burford Bridge) turn right towards Box Hill and Mickleham. Continue past the Burford Bridge Hotel and the turning for Box Hill. Continue over a small hill. Juniper Hall is at the bottom of the hill on the right hand side.
