

## Stained Glass: Christmas Wreath



The location of many of John Constable's paintings, Flatford Mill runs over 120 Natural History and Arts courses in a unique and tranquil learning environment.

### Course Overview

On this one day course you will make a copperfoiled glass Christmas wreath, approx. 28cm/11" wide. The course is a practical one and includes glass cutting, copperfoiling and soldering.



All the materials and tools required for the course will be supplied.

Refreshments and lunch will be served in the Mill dining room and are included in the fee.

**Carole Gray** is a designer and maker of decorative stained glass, who uses many of the traditional techniques practised by stained glass artists over the centuries to create work which is highly contemporary and decorative.

### What to Bring

An apron or coverall - you should not have open shoes or bare legs.

Rubber gloves (such as washing up gloves).

A paper face mask (optional).

#### Health & Safety:

You must not wear open shoes or have bare legs (even if the weather is warm). Do not wear loose clothing or dangly jewellery as it may get caught in machinery.

Long hair must be tied back.

Please note that you will not be able to work in the studio unless supervised by the tutor.

The studio will not be accessible during the lunch and dinner breaks, or after teaching finishes in the evening at around 2100 hrs.

**If you are pregnant or breastfeeding** you should consult your GP before enrolling on this course as working with solder (lead/tin) can be harmful to the developing baby.

### Course fees

The course fee includes a glass pack, home-cooked lunch, tea, coffee and afternoon cake.
