ethnic minority
backgrounds spent
less time outside
since coronavirus
compared with **57%**
of white children.



83%
of children agreed
that being in
nature made
them very happy.



48%
of children reported that
being worried about
catching / spreading coronavirus
stopped them from spending
more time outside.



70%
of children said in the future
they want to spend more time
outdoors with friends and
44% wanted to spend more
time outdoors at school.



56%
of 8-11 year olds said park
closures stopped them
from spending time
outside.
