Why help clean the beaches?

Virtually all plastic ever made still exists, and it is believed it will take between 500 and 1,000 years for it to degrade. But, even when it starts to break down, it does so into tiny pieces which we are starting to find in a growing number of places, many seabirds, cetaceans, turtles, and a growing number of fish have been found with plastic inside their bodies and now also inside the food we eat and bottled water too.

So please come and help us reduce the amount of plastic on Slapton Sands.
