

# Activities

Enhance your visit by taking part in an organised activity, these are designed to be enjoyed by all ages!

| Outdoor Learning Activities – half day or full day |  |

| <b>Guided nature walk - day or evening</b>         | One of our expert tutors will introduce you to the beautiful landscape around our Centre and highlight key geographical features, local plants and animals.  |
| <b>Compass orienteering</b>                        | Using key orienteering skills to explore inspirational landscapes, groups will quickly and accurately navigate through challenges and problems – mistakes cost time! An excellent team-building activity, you will be using map reading, orientation and compass abilities, to find your way through unfamiliar terrain. |
| <b>Wilderness bushcraft</b>                        | What do you need to survive a night in the wilderness? You will work in teams to build your own shelters and have a go at lighting a fire using natural materials. Depending on the length of the session, you may also have a go at making elder beads, whittling and cooking some nettle tea to have round the fire.   |
| <b>Team challenges</b>                             | An exciting and challenging introduction to the concepts of working well together, using a wide variety of fun activities and puzzles designed to encourage problem solving and teamwork.  |
| <b>Evening Campfire - evening</b>                  | We provide the fire and the hot chocolate, and you bring the entertainment, stories and music.   |
| <b>Mammal Trapping &amp; Observation</b>           | Get up close to some of our secretive small mammals. Have a go at using live-catch traps to observe small mammals on the centre grounds. This session could also include some bat listening or use of a moth trap. Mammal trapping is an evening and short morning activity.   |
| <b>Secret Ponds</b>                                | Explore pond margins for signs of life and collect using pond dipping equipment. Then follow up in one of our laboratories to identify pond invertebrates hidden from everyday view.   |

## Please note:

- All activities £13.50 per person.\*
- All activities must be booked in advance - to avoid disappointment we recommend booking as early as possible (at least 3 months ahead of your visit date).
- Minimum group size is 10.
- Session length is up to 2 hrs.
- Suitable for any age but all children must be accompanied by a full paying adult.
