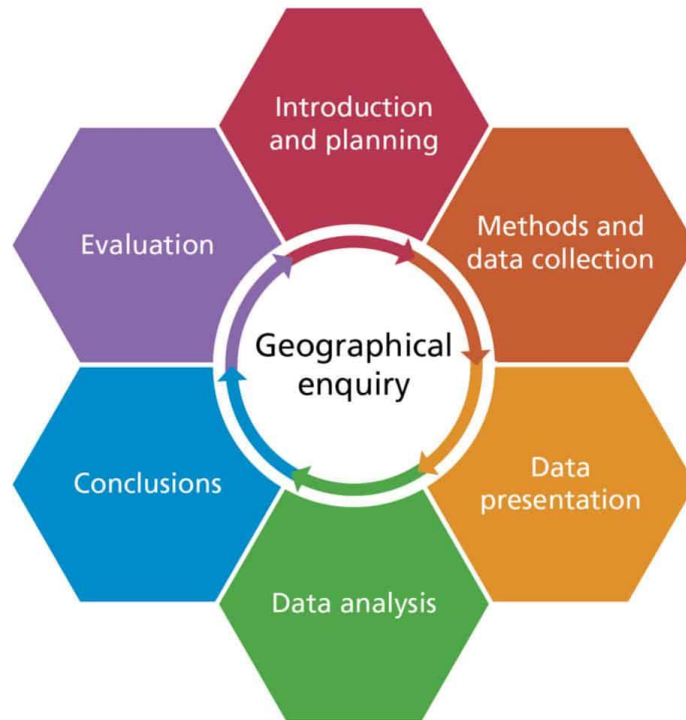


Route to Enquiry

From the evaluation, another enquiry can be formulated.



Data Analysis

If you're looking at the relationship between two things, is there a correlation? Is it positive or negative? Is it strong or weak?

If you are comparing two (or more) things, how do their mean averages compare? Do any other analysis techniques further strengthen your conclusion (eg. mode, median or range)?

Conclusion

Look at your original enquiry question. In your conclusion, you are answering your question, using the data that you've collected as evidence.
