Dating back to the 18<sup>th</sup> century, Juniper Hall is filled with history and character, boasting modern facilities that have been adapted through the years. Just a stone's throw away from the hustle and bustle of London, Juniper Hall offers a tranquil country escape within easy reach.

## What do we offer?



### **Self-led**

Hire a work/meeting room for a half or full day to host your own meeting, workshop or event. We have multiple rooms available, each with interactive whiteboard/IT facilities with support for setting up and unlimited Wi-Fi. We offer free parking, and the opportunity to explore and enjoy our centre's beautiful grounds. Basic refreshments are provided with full catering options available.

### **Centre-led**

Customisable half or full day activities to suit your group's needs and preferences. Choose from a range of exciting activities, detailed below. Some have an added environmental theme, some offer well-being and mindfulness experiences, whilst others purely encourage teamwork to enhance communication, boost confidence and adopt better problem-solving skills. An activity can also be added to a self-led day. Basic refreshments are provided with full catering options available.

### **Away Stays (Stop-over package)**

Why not make a night of it? Choose our stop-over package and enjoy more time to relax and rejuvenate. Our centre offers overnight accommodation in a range of room types to suit all budgets, sleeping up to 145 at full capacity. Overnight stays include full board, and can be added to self/centre-led bookings or booked as accommodation only. Evening activities can also be added to your programme to make the most of your visit.

## Transport



Juniper Hall is easily accessible by both car and train, making it an ideal location for corporate away days. We are just a short drive from the M25 and A24, with free on-site parking available. For those travelling by public transport, Dorking's mainline stations (with direct services from London Waterloo, Victoria and Reading) are only a 10-minute taxi ride away, ensuring quick and convenient connections.

## Health and Safety



All sessions are risk assessed and led by experienced teaching staff with specialist knowledge and expertise. All education staff hold first aid qualifications and are trained in H&S and group management. The Field Studies Council holds the Quality Badge from The Council for Learning Outside the Classroom, which is awarded to organisations which have demonstrated that they consistently deliver high quality teaching and learning experiences and manage risk effectively.



## Outdoor Equipment

All specialist outdoor equipment is provided as part of your visit, ensuring everyone can take part comfortably and safely. We can also provide waterproof jackets and trousers if required; so there's no need to worry about packing specialist kit.



## Activity Options and Session Details

<h3>Bushcraft</h3> <p>Venture into inspiring local habitats, engage in fun, hands-on activities to reconnect with nature and thrive in the natural environment. The wild outdoors provides the backdrop for the exploration of camouflage, foraging, fire lighting, shelter building and making useful items from natural materials. Bushcraft sessions allow participants to learn new skills in a supportive setting.</p>	<h3>Wellbeing Walk</h3> <p>Take time away from a busy schedule to pause and breathe on a walk through the grounds and surrounding woodlands of Juniper Hall. Learn to identify different trees and their characteristics and learn about animal habitats and their homes. The walk is completed at a gentle pace with stops along the way to pause, reflect and incorporate mindfulness exercises and creative activities.</p>
<h3>Team Challenges &amp; Orienteering</h3> <p>Getting to know each other in a new context; improve communication and teamwork skills via a series of activities. Try out our orienteering course around our grounds, using a map to find markers!</p>	<h3>Woodland Wanderers</h3> <p>Discover the hidden secrets in our ancient woodlands. Use your senses to explore, learn about woodland plants and creatures and develop new identification skills.</p>

## Activity Notes

- Each activity is approximately two hours with fringe time for refreshment and toilet breaks, being suitable for a morning and/or afternoon depending on your schedule.
- Your programme will be tailored to your group's requirements after contact between you and the Juniper Hall team.
- The order of activities may vary due to weather and to avoid equipment/venue clashes.



## Catering Options

Our catering team is well equipped to cater to all needs and occasions. From basic refreshments provided for all visits, to full meals tailored to your requirements.
